Proud Cloud in each class: choose a class target, celebrate when all children achieve it

Postcard certificates home for going "above and beyond"

House Points

Always "catch" children doing the right thing

Consequences / Repair

After 3 steps: timeout in another room for 5 minutes

Back into room for fresh start

If behaviour continues: timeout again

If behaviour continues or serious incident: parents informed

Record on CPOMs

30 second Interventions

Step 1: Reminder - check in, are you ok? We have three simple rules
Be Safe, Be Ready,
Be Respectful

Step 2: Clear verbal caution - think carefully about your next step, remember The Charles Darwin Way

Step 3: Last chance - speak to child privately, use phrases

Step 4: Time out - in another class. 5 minutes to breathe / cool down

<u>Step 5:</u> Repair - think it over together.
